Admission For Master Degree Programs

Admission Requirements

Important information for the admission of non-Iranian applicants:

1: General conditions for non-Iranian students' admission

- a. Having a Bachelor's degree to apply for a Master's program.
- b. Having a Master's degree to apply for the specialized Doctoral programs.
- c. Having a minimum grade point average of 14 out of 20 or the equivalent of 70 out of 100 to enter undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral programs (for all fields of study).

Note: Applicants can apply for admission to the university after completing the course and before receiving a degree or defending their dissertation. But this admission is subject to receiving a degree or defending the dissertation before the end of the semester and enrollment. The applicant's admission will be canceled if the applicant does not present the degree or the defense minutes before the final registration.

2. Required documents for admission:

- The Complet online application Form
- The previous educational degree(s)
- A valid passport or residence card
- A recent Personnel photo
- Curriculum Vitae
- A Letter of commitment to complete the previous educational program for applicants who are studying their final semester

Application Fees:

Application fees are defined by 2.730.000 Rials.



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3. Document related notes.

- **Note 1.** Degrees and transcripts issued by foreign schools and universities must be approved by the representative offices of the Islamic Republic of Iran in that country or the embassy of the applicant country in Iran and if they are not in English, they must be translated officially into Persian or English.
- **Note 2.** A diploma issued by Afghanistan to enter a Bachelor's program must be stamped by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Afghanistan and the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Kabul.
- **Note** 3. In case of any discrepancy between the applicant's admission and registration conditions and the rules of the procedure, the applicant will be prevented from continuing the admission and education.

Admission Process

How to apply for admission:

After ensuring that the conditions of the university are met, the applicant must first send the application along with the requested documents to the email address info@gias.ge Admission steps will be implemented by the Office of International Students upon completion of the application.

Acceptance time:

- 1. First semester period:
 - Submission of applications by applicants from 15 July to 31 September.
- 2. Second semester period:
 - Submission of applications by applicants from January 6 to March 20.

Note: According to the rules of admission regulation for non-Iranian students approved by the esteemed board of the University of Tehran on July 17, 2021, applications sent after the end of the announced time periods for each semester will not be processed and they can be reviewed for the next semester.



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Registration

Registration documents:

- Personal photo
- Presenting the tuition payment receipt for the first semester.
- Presenting the original high school diploma or the degree of the previous level and the original identity documents.
- Presenting a Persian language proficiency test certificate for courses held in Persian.

In-person Registration

In the face-to-face registration, after the applicant refers to the Office of International Students, the admission colleagues examine the announced documents then the Accounting Department colleagues introduce the applicant to the bank to pay the tuition fee. After paying the tuition fee and confirming the payment receipt by the accounting Department of the International office, the applicant will be introduced to the General Directorate of Educational Services for registration in a letter with the permission of the Ministry of Science and the bank receipt.

In absentia Registration

Due to the situation following the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic and the absence of accepted applicants in the country, vice-President for International Affairs has registered them in absentia to help these people in coordination with the University Educational Services Department without paying tuition. Therefore, when registering, the applicant has to send pictures of all required documents via email to the Admissions Department of the Office of International Students, and sign the picture of the tuition payment and presenting the original document commitment letter in his or her presentation in the country then send them to the admission colleagues including his or her contact information.
